Oversubscription Criteria

If the number of preferences for the school is more than the number of places available, places will be allocated in the following priority order –

- A) Children in Local Authority Care. A child under 18 years of age for whom the Local Authority provides accommodation by agreement with their parents/carers (section 20 of the Children Act 1989) or who is subject of a care order under part IV of the Act.
- B) Children with siblings attending Pent Valley Technology College at the time of entry including natural, fostered and adopted children and half siblings and step siblings.
- C) Children on roll at St. Mary's Church of England Primary School on 1st September in the year preceding transfer to secondary school.
- D) Nearness of children's homes to the school. The distance is measured between the child's permanent address and the school measured in a straight line using Ordnance Survey address point data. The school uses measurements provided by the Local Authority and further information on how distances are calculated are available in the admissions booklets provided by the Local Authority.

Sixth Form Admissions arrangements:

Students of Pent Valley Technology College have the right to transfer into the sixth form. Pent Valley Technology College will take great care to ensure that students enrol onto courses of the appropriate level. If such courses are not available in a student's chosen area of study, then the student will be guided to find alternative provision elsewhere.

Applications from external students to join Pent Valley Technology College's sixth form are welcomed. You should complete the Pent Valley Technology College's application form, which can be obtained from the school. Applications should be made in accordance with the process described in the sixth form prospectus.

Priority will be given to existing pupils transferring from Year 11. The PAN for external candidates will be 20 but this figure may be exceeded in the event that this and the number of internal pupils transferring into Year 12 is less than the overall total figure for the Year group which is 210.

In the event of oversubscription on a particular course, places will be allocated in line with the oversubscription criteria used at the normal point of entry.

Transport

Pupils living in the following areas and parishes are eligible for free transport if they live more than three miles away: Cheriton, Newington and parts of West Folkestone.
